# Activation Assignment; Grade 11 Spanish

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You will need a computer and a microphone.

Before you do anything, create a folder on your computer called Spanish 11 where all the files you will do for me will be placed. You can save this page and use the 15 questions below to provide your answers. Now, you are ready to start.

**First**, you need to click on the attachment named "[Activation Spanish 11.wav](#)" that was located next to this file, and listen to the one minute message. You can play it again and again. Then answer questions in English of what you understood from the oral file.

Once it is completed, you can just cut and paste it in an email or send it as an attachment. Your name should be in the name of the file and in the subject line with your name and send it to me. When I receive it, I will send you a confirmation.

**Second**, you should produce an oral presentation of yourself in Spanish (like the one from the first activity). This presentation should be done orally (on an audio file).

This presentation will be for about one minute in Spanish and should include:

- Your name, age, personal physical description
- Your family; brothers, sisters, parents, relatives, pets
- Where you live, a description of your physical environment

You do not need to include things that you find to be of personal nature.

Once you have decided what you will say, I suggest that you write it down. If you are not too sure about how certain words are pronounced, you can call me or send me an email.

The easiest way to record an audio file is as follows: click on START menu at the bottom left of your screen, then click on programs, then on accessories, then on entertainment and lastly on sound recorder. When you are ready to begin, click on the brown dot and say your presentation. It will give you one minute and then it will cut, you can redo it many times. Click on file to save it. Name it using your name, activation 10 (e.g. geraldcaronspanish11.wav). You should keep a copy of you work in Spanish 11 file in your computer.

You could also do it using your MP3 player using the function record or even with a camera as an audio and video file.

If you have tried, but it seems too hard for you, you can submit it as a written document (using Word or another word processor) and complete sentences.

Online translators or dictionaries could be used as tools, but only for individual words or small word groups. Too often, if you use online translators for complete texts the results are disastrous and barely understandable.
